



## ***Read Before You Install: HP TP Desktop Connector Version 5.0 for ACMS***

Dear Customer:

This letter includes information on *HP TP Desktop Connector* for ACMS that you should be aware of before installing the product. Most importantly, this letter contains your product license key that is required to install and access the product. You should retain this document for future reference.

Beginning February 21, 2006, the TP Desktop Connector is licensed as part of the ACMS product. A valid ACMS product license provides the right to use the TP Desktop Connector product. Refer to the Software Product Description for more information (SPD # 34.81.23).

### ***Features and Enhancements***

The following is a list of the new features or enhancements that have been incorporated into this release of the product:

- Items that were previously documented only in the Release Notes have been added into the product documentation set
- All product documentation and media have been brought up to the latest HP branding standards
- Documentation changes to reflect retired features
- TPware .NET Plugin has been implemented to take advantage of the .NET Platform

## **Installation Information**

## **Client Installation**

The *setup.exe* program takes you step-by-step through the Windows client install procedure. When making the product selections in the TPware installation, a dialog box appears prompting for the entry of a product license key. The product license key to access the client is:

## **Gateway Installation**

The gateway is installed on your server system enabling access to ACMS. Make sure that the required Product Authorization Key (PAK) is registered and loaded before using the standard VMSINSTAL procedure.
