

Is Your Hardware Supported?

Since the final build of the Solaris™ 2.6 CD-ROM that you have just received, hardware support for new system platforms and peripherals, shown on Solaris 2.6 x86 Hardware Compatibility List updates, has been made available through Solaris 2.6 x86 Driver Updates.

The Solaris Driver Update is the distribution mechanism by which new device drivers and hardware support modules are made available to Solaris customers free of charge. Driver Updates are issued periodically. They can be obtained through:

- The Internet via the World Wide Web at: **<http://access1.Sun.COM>** or from several anonymous FTP sites
- CompuServe (type **go sunsoft**)
- SunSoft Sales by calling 1-800-SUNSOFT, option 1, "software upgrade," and requesting the current Solaris 2.6 x86 Driver Update diskettes (for which a shipping charge may be incurred). Outside the U.S., contact your technical support provider or call 310-348-6219 (ASK-IT) for Driver Update information.
