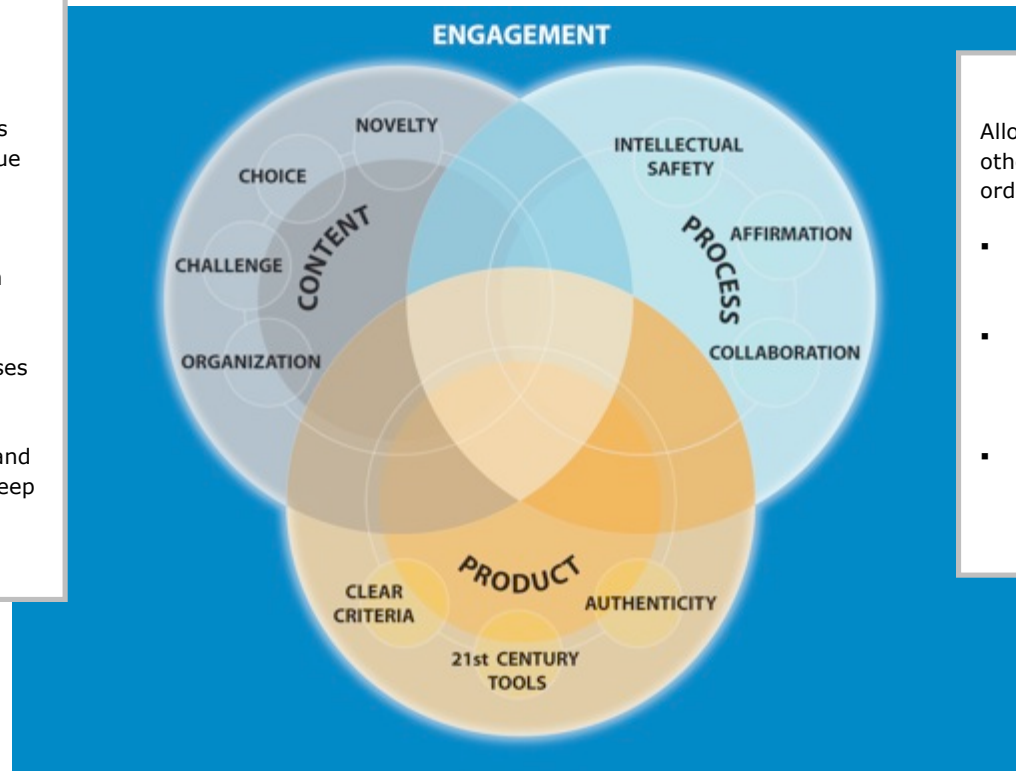


Model for Student Engagement

CONTENT

Select, organize, and present content in ways that engage students.

- Novelty: Present students with new content in unique ways to increase engagement.
- Choice: Give students choices in how they learn
- Organization: Organize content in a way that is approachable and increases self-efficacy.
- Challenge: Balance the sense of increasing skill and increasing challenge to keep students interested in content.



PROCESS

Allow students to connect with others to discuss content in order to deepen understanding.

- Intellectual safety: Ensure students feel free to take risks without fear of failure.
- Affirmation: Offer students the opportunity to have their work affirmed by those who are significant to them.
- Collaboration: Ensure students have opportunities to work with others.

PRODUCT

Support students in creating authentic intellectual work to increase engagement.

- Clear criteria: Ensure students have a clear understanding of work assessment criteria.
- 21st century tools: Use technology to encourage rich, authentic learning.
- Authenticity: Teach students to use content, improve deep learning, and recognize that their work has value beyond the classroom.
