

LOADING FANTASY MANAGER.

If you are going to run FANTASY MANAGER from a floppy disk, place that disk in the proper drive. Access that drive and type bfm to load it.

Ex. If you were going to run the program from your A: drive you would do the following:

<u>Type</u>	<u>Result</u>
A: (enter)	You will log onto the A: drive
bfm (enter)	The Fantasy Manager program will begin

If you are going to run FANTASY MANAGER from your hard drive, create a directory and copy the files from the disk to the hard drive. Type bfm from the hard drive to load it.

Ex. If you were going to run the program from your hard drive you would do the following:

<u>Type</u>	<u>Result</u>
C: (enter)	This will ensure you are logged onto your hard drive.
cd\ (enter)	This will ensure you will not be in any other directory you already have on your hard drive.
md bfm (enter)	You will make a new directory named bfm
cd bfm	You will change into the bfm directory
copy <drive letter>: *.* (enter)	You will copy all the information from the floppy drive (usually A: or B:) to the bfm directory.
bfm (enter)	The Fantasy Manager program will begin

The next time you would like to use the Fantasy Manager Program all you will need to do is change into the bfm directory and type bfm and the program will begin. Remember, everytime the program is loaded you will be requested to type a password to start the program. All of the passwords are from the manual and the program tells you what page and line to find the word.

Addendum to Manual

Com Port: This is used to refer to the communications port your modem is using. The possible ports are COM 1, COM 2, COM 3, and COM 4. If you are unsure of which com port you are using, ask the person who installed the modem or refer to the modem's user manual.

Telenet / Tymnet: These are the data communications networks that provide you with a local "node" or access number to call in order to connect to the Stats Service on the USA TODAY Sports Center, Greensboro, NC. This way you do not have to call long distance in order to take advantage of the Stats Service. To find out the number in your local area, call the toll free numbers that appear on page 16 of the manual.

No Online Charges: On page ten, paragraph one, there is a mention of "keeping your online charges to a minimum". There are no online charges associated with the downloading of stats from USA TODAY. As of the printing of this insert, two download packages are available. For \$119.95 you can download stats 30 times. For \$24.95 you can download stats 6 times. Single downloads are available for \$5.00 each once you have chosen one of the above plans.

The first time you connect to the USA TODAY Sports Center you will receive one complimentary stats download. The free stats downloads are updated daily until the All-Star break. After the All-Star break the free stats are no longer updated, but are still available for you to download. The second time you attempt to download stats please have your credit card information ready. You can then quickly select your package and download your next set of stats.

Below are corrections to documentation found on page 10, paragraph 1.

Member Handle: This is your nine digit number that is found on the inside back cover of the manual. This gives you an individual account to the Stats Service on the USA TODAY Sports Center.

Password: This is also located on the inside back cover of your manual. It is the key to your account on the USA TODAY Sports Center. **For security purposes do not give out either your Member Handle or Password to anyone.**
