



QUICK START CARD

OBJECT OF THE GAME

Players win money by correctly guessing names, places, titles or phrases that are being drawn by the computer. The team with the most money at the end of the game wins.

SET UP

Answer the questions on your computer screen to set up teams and begin play. Use the arrow keys to highlight your answer and then press RETURN or ENTER.

RULES

The game consists of three rounds plus a Speed Round.

In each round, the computer draws a picture on the screen. While the picture is drawn, type in as many words as needed to guess the correct answer. Press RETURN or ENTER after typing each word or sequence of words.

If you guess a word correctly, it will appear in the upper right hand corner of the screen. To win the round, you must type the entire title of the picture and press RETURN or ENTER, even if you have previously guessed each word in the title correctly.

In Rounds One, Two and Three each team has one minute to guess the answer. Your earnings depend upon the length of time you take to guess the picture:

Seconds	Earnings
15	\$500
20	\$400
25	\$300
30	\$200
31 or more	\$100

If a team does not correctly guess the answer in the one minute time limit, the other team will have a chance to guess. If neither team guesses correctly, neither team receives the money.

The team that is ahead at the end of Round Three goes first in the Speed Round. Each team has ninety seconds to guess seven one-word pictures.

To skip a picture and move on to the next word:

- IBM and Apple users, press the Tab key.
- Commodore users, press F7.

Each correctly guessed word is worth \$100. If you solve all of the puzzles, your team earns an additional \$100. You can then earn bonus dollars if you guess all of the puzzles before the time runs out. This means that for every 10 seconds left on the clock, your team earns an extra \$100.

For example, your team guesses all of the puzzles correctly and there are 22 seconds left:

- \$700 for completing all of the Speed Round puzzles
- \$100 for finishing with time left on the clock
- \$200 for the 22 seconds left on the clock

The total points awarded for the Speed Round example is \$1,000. At the end of the Speed Round, the winning team earns an extra \$1,000.

QUITTING A GAME

If you wish to quit the game early, press the ESC key (Commodore users: Turn off your computer).
