***Before You Install the Compaq TeMIP Map Editor and Symbols Editor V4.1***

Dear Customer,

Compaq is delighted that you have chosen the Compaq TeMIP Map Editor/Symbols Editor V4.1 as part of your network management requirements.

Enclosed is the Compaq TeMIP Map Editor/Symbols Editor software kit and documentation.

Please read this cover letter before installing the kit.

**Map Editor**

The Compaq TeMIP Map Editor allows you to create map files and display them in the Map Viewer of a running TeMIP Client application. In addition, you can display existing map files in the Map Editor and edit and save them to suit changing circumstances.

The Map Editor provides both graphical editing capabilities and specific TeMIP editing features such as map hierarchy definition and the ability to select map item propagation attributes.

Standard graphical functions such as drawing lines, move/size/fill an object, undo ..., are available, and you can also define the properties of addressable (dynamic) objects in a map.

Map files can be separated into layers. A layer can be a backdrop or a collection of dynamic map items that can, for example, appear/disappear when a zoom in/zoom out operation is carried out.

**Symbols Editor**

The Compaq TeMIP Symbols Editor allows you to create symbols for inclusion in TeMIP Client map files. These map files can in turn be displayed in the Map Viewer of a running TeMIP Client application. You can create any number of symbol variations and save them in a "palette". A palette provides a way of storing symbols according to theme.

The Symbols Editor provides standard graphical editing capabilities that enable you to draw, manipulate and modify existing symbols. In addition, you can associate a dynamic description with a symbol that specifies changes to be made in response to changes in application variables such as severity color. The dynamic description associated with a symbol can be tested in the Symbols Editor window.

**Contents of the Software Kit**

Your kit includes the Compaq TeMIP Map Editor/Symbols Editor software distribution media together with the documentation set in HTML format. The documentation set consists of:

- Compaq TeMIP Map and Symbols Editor User's Guide (AA-XXXXXX-TE)

The documentation set corresponds with the functions that you have purchased.

Note that you will only be able to use the software for which you have purchased licenses.

## Release Notes

Release Notes can be printed out during installation. The Release Notes contain information such as recommendations, amendments to documentation and restrictions.

Refer to the *Compaq TeMIP Client for Windows NT Installation and Configuration Guide* (AA-REG1C-TE) for information on how to access the Release Notes.

This product uses the FLEXlm Software License Key system.

A FLEXlm key must be obtained using information provided with the license deliverable. An Authorization ID is provided for each license, which allows the user to generate license keys from the Compaq License Key Fulfilment Web Site according to instructions provided with the license agreement.
