A UNIQUELY EUROPEAN HERITAGE

1948 was a truly vintage year for Europe's most illustrious automotive marques. But of all the vehicles at that year's Amsterdam Motor Show, none was to have such long-term impact as the stubby, purposeful machine on the Land Rover stand. After forty years of taming deeply rutted tracks, dense jungle and mountain passes, the Land Rover enjoys a reputation of legendary proportions - and today, it still rules the world's wildest places. But even a Land Rover could go further. Inevitably, some drivers craved a vehicle combining its unsurpassed ruggedness with West End elegance; a vehicle in which uncompromising function and value blended with true craftsmanship and luxury. After all, why shouldn't the precision of a Purdey shotgun go hand in hand with the tailoring of a Gieves & Hawkes suit? In 1970, such a vehicle finally appeared. Christened "Range Rover", it was equally at home on a snowy mountain trail, motorway fast lane, or Mayfair's Park Lane. For while its immensely strong chassis and permanent four-wheel drive made it an authentic off-road vehicle, its supple suspension, luxury appointments and aluminium V8 engine rivalled those of a European touring sedan. Proved, developed and honed over the years, the Range Rover is arguably, the world's most desirable on or off road sport utility vehicle, with many imitators, but few, if any, rivals. It is a consummately

crafted, utterly British package.






ADVENTURE WITHOUT FEAR

For all its Savile Row tailoring, its Noel Coward manners, a Range Rover is - as the English put it as hard as nails. If it could not take nature's (and high society's) toughest challenges in its stride, it would never have been built - and students of the archetypal English Gentleman will recall that a few years back, Major John Blashford-Snell conquered the notorious Darien Gap, at the wheel of a Range Rover. At the heart of this paragon is the unique permanent four-wheel drive technology pioneered, developed and perfected by Land Rover. With its dual range transfer case, the smooth-changing four-speed automatic transmission provides eight forward and two reverse gears; and the relentless power of its highly developed, fuel injected engine drives through a viscous coupling centre differential - that automatically adjusts the amount of power transmitted to the front and rear axles, providing increased wheel traction in adverse conditions. For all its off-road aptitude, however, a Range Rover's greatest attribute is its combination of conceptual common sense and all-round abilities. Abilities that both foster and reward the spirit of

THE HIGH PERFORMER

With all the reserve of a good butler, Range Rover's
3.9 litre V8 delivers 178 bhp at 4,750 rpm and a massive
220 lb.ft. of torque at 3,250 rpm – making this the
most powerful production version ever built. Such a
thoroughbred is well up to more than 100 mph on
Europe's autobahns, easily up to a 1 in 2 Rockies
gradient – and its integral Class III towing hitch
receiver gives some idea of its versatile prowess. But it's
not just what the Range Rover does, it's how it does it.
On the motorway, the powerful V8 engine, with its
four-speed automatic transmission and lock-up torque
converter, endows this formidable machine with long-

four large disc brakes. And whether cruising down the highway, or making light work of some remote high place, those specially designed tyres, on their handsome alloy wheels, provide masterly grip – while the 8" ground clearance shrugs off rocky terrain.

In short, Range Rover performance is an equation transcending the basics of power, speed and agility.

When the pursuit of freedom is the name of the game, its all-round excellence provides an enticing solution.

UNCOMPROMISING LUXURY

The lavish Range Rover interior is now yet more palatial – so complete is the equipment that the only options are Connolly hide upholstery and a power slide and tilt sunroof. Evocatively European and graced by polished walnut, the atmosphere is one of functionally elegant opulence. Whether optional leather or colourcoded cloth is specified, the ergonomically designed front seats have 8-way power adjustment.

And comprehensive instrumentation keeps the driver thoroughly informed. In the back, the double-folding seat, with convenient 60/40 split, provides up to 70.6 cu. ft. of luggage space – while the two-piece tailgate doubles as an excellent picnic platform.

Advanced heating, ventilation and air-conditioning, plus a six- speaker stereo radio/cassette system (guarded by a theft deterrent device) provides whatever ambience matches the mood of the day.

But, for all its amenities, Range Rover luxury is based on attributes far more fundamental than a high level of equipment. And its luxurious accoutrements would be quite out of place without the complete integrity of the basic concept.



LUXURY FEATURES

AM/FM stereo cassette audio system with six speakers, electronic tuning, auto loudness, radio monitor and theft deterrent device. Rear windscreen antenna.

Air conditioning, heating and ventilation system with 3 speed fan, 5 adjustable vents, rear extractor grilles, demister to side windows, heater duct to rear passenger footwell.

Power windows with single touch driver side opening. Rear window lockout feature.

Central door locking includes fuel filler cover and tailgate.

Child locks on rear doors.

Cruise control.

Tinted glass.

Removable woven carpeting over rubber floor mats.

Electrically adjusted and heated, outside rear view mirrors with fold-away feature.

Heated front windscreen.

Heated rear window.

Heated front windscreen washer jets.

Power wash to front headlamps.

Multi-function front windshield wipers incorporating flick wipe, adjustable intermittent wipe and programmed wash and wipe sequence. Rear wash and wipe system with intermittent facility.

Front door puddle lamps and door open warning lamps, engine compartment inspection light, delay action on interior lamps.



INDOMITABLE STRENGTH

Range Rover's immensely rigid chassis is an object lesson in off-road endurance. Following established Land Rover practice, it comprises a wax-injected, 14 gauge, welded steel ladder design frame, capable of treating the roughest going, the heaviest loads, with easy indifference. Above it is a welded steel inner body cage, to which the outer body panels are bolted. The majority of these panels are fashioned in lightweight aluminium - which lowers the centre of gravity for improved stability and poise. This formula of rugged refinement is also applied to the suspension. Coil sprung all round, dual rated at the rear, and complemented by a sophisticated rear-mounted hydraulic ride-levelling unit, it ensures luxury sedan comfort, regardless of load. And wheel travel of 8" (front) and II" (rear) tackles the most violent undulations with regal aplomb. Throughout the Range Rover, strength integrated with finesse epitomizes the iron fist in the velvet glove.






RANGE ROVER

ITS MOST NOTABLE QUALITY IS QUALITY

Quality of materials, of engineering, of craftsmanship - and, above all, quality of thought, these are the essentials of such a traditionally wrought, yet utterly contemporary vehicle. An obvious example is the fourwheel drive system - which, for all its cross-country prowess, was the first specially designed to enhance the driveability of a vehicle that will, inevitably, spend more time on the road. Sheer quality of thought shows in the details, too. Puddle lamps under the front doors, for when Lobb dress shoes, rather than hiking boots, are the chosen footwear. Power adjustable, electrically heated mirrors, that fold away when encountering off-road obstacles - and crowded parking lots. Heated front windscreen, heated screenwash jets, heated rear window, rear wash/wipe - and power washers for the headlamps, (An ignition override actually turns the last-mentioned into parking lamps, should you leave them on). The way the power windows include single-touch driver window opening, to minimize toll booth delays - and the central locking system also includes the fuel filler cover and tailgate. From top to bottom a Range Rover is an amalgam of traditional values and state-of-the-art execution. And, to take liberties with another great English institution - Shakespeare: 'the quality of mastery is not


strained; it riseth to whatever the occasion.





THE CAR THAT CARES

Anthropomorphic, admittedly: but, as is well known, Europeans are inclined to endow special cars with almost human qualities. And there's certainly no doubt that if any car cares for the humans inside it, this is the one. The uniquely elevated driving position - that helps the cross-country driver avoid obstacles enables the same driver to see further ahead on the road. The permanent four-wheel drive is a positive boon on snow, ice and other treacherous surfaces - yet responsive power steering provides the easy maneuverability of a far smaller vehicle. The driver and passengers enjoy an environment that provides an exceptional level of comfort on long journeys. The inherent strength of the bodyshell is complemented by child locks on rear doors and windows. The technology, engineering and reliability, to which the Range Rover owes its formidable reputation, play as crucial a role in everyday commuting as they do in the most amibitious expedition.



BEYOND SUBJECTIVITY: AN ENGINEER'S VIEW.

Many and complex are the factors determining an individual's choice of car.

But, for those who look beyond social aspiration, who see through emotional ploys, there is a bottom line: how the car is designed and built; how its specification matches its role; in short, plain facts.

The following specification not only provides a detailed, objective analysis of the car's construction; it also demonstrates that, in an increasingly cynical world, a Range Rover remains what it always has been: extraordinary value.

ENGINE

V8 engine of cast aluminum construction with five main bearing crankshaft and self-adjusting hydraulic tappets. Multi-point Electronic Fuel Injection.

TRANSMISSION

Four speed automatic. Epicyclic gearbox with fluid torque converter and fourth gear lock up. Kickdown and manual override feature.

TRANSFER GEARBOX

Permanent four-wheel drive system. Two-speed reduction on gearbox output.

High ratio: 1.206:1 Low ratio: 3.243:1

Front and rear drive permanently engaged via a centre (inter-axle) differential which allows four-wheel drive to operate on pavement for extra security. This differential is fitted with a viscous coupling unit (VCU). Upon sensing loss of traction, the viscosity of VCU fluid increases, creating a locking effect which provides equal power distribution (50/50 torque split) to both drive shafts. Once traction is regained, VCU locking effect is reduced automatically.

AXLES

Beam axles front and rear, incorporating spiral bevel type differentials with fully floating axle shafts. Front axle incorporates fully enclosed constant velocity joints. Axle differential ratio: 3.54:1



Long travel coil springs, dual rate at rear. Axle location by radius arms with panhard rod at front, trailing links and central "A" frame at rear. Longstroke hydraulic telescopic dampers. Spring Rates: Vehicle Wheel Travel:

RIDE LEVELLING DEVICE

Maintenance-free, self energizing ride-levelling device on rear axle assists in maintaining normal vehicle attitude when loaded.



BRAKING SYSTEM


Self adjusting servo-assisted, hydraulic disc brakes on all four wheels. (Total swept area 477 sq. ins.). Positive, drum-type parking brake operates on the transfer case output shaft.


STEERING

Power-assisted steering of worm and roller type to minimize kick-back. Steering damper is incorporated. Turns lock to lock: 3.375

WHEELS AND TYRES

Cast Aluminum Alloy Wheels, size 7 x 16 in., 5 stud. Asymmetrical wheel "hump" design helps keep tyre on rim in event of a blow out. All purpose XM+S 24+ radial tyres, 205 R16 size. Identical spare wheel and tyre.





RESPECT FOR NATURE

With the freedom afforded by four-wheel drive comes the responsibility to protect the environment. Keep four wheeling a positive, safe recreational porsuit.

CONSTRUCTION (CHASSIS & BODY)

Electrophoretically treated, 14 gauge steel welded box section chassis. "Ladder" design. Pressed steel inner body cage. Outer body panels, except tailgate area and bonner, made of lightweight, rustproof aluminum allor.

SEATING

Ergonomically designed, eight-way adjustable and reclining front seats. Dual front adjustable arm rests. Rear seats provide room for three passengers. Seat is double folding asymmetrical design with 60/40 split. Centre and two rear side arm rests. (Cloth interior is standard, unless optional Connolly hide is specified.).

TOWING

Strong ladder frame construction with 5 cross members, robust suspension and ride levelling device along with integral Class III towing hitch receiver are ideally suited to trailer towing:

MISCELLANEOUS

12v negative ground system uses a heavy-duty, maintenance-free battery, with an 80 amp alternator. Easily-accessible fuses. Constant energy electronic ignition. Quartz halogen headlamps (60 watt high/ 50 watt low beam) and auxiliary driving lamps in front air dam. Dual sunvisors with vanity mirrors, passenger assist handle, rear mud flaps, two cigar-lighters and ash travs. Left foot rest pad.

INSTRUMENTATION/CONTROLS

Main binnacle, with adjustable illumination, incorporates a comprehensive array of instruments: speedometer, tachometer, fuel gauge, water temperature gauge, odometer, trip meter, warning lights for low brake fluid, coolant and windscreen wash fluid. Ignition switch-on gives bulb check for the 14 functions covered by warning lights.

Auxiliary control panel contains switches for master cruise control, auxiliary driving lamps, interior dome light, heated front windscreen and rear tailgate defroster.

Steering column-mounted controls operate rear washer/wiper, variable speed/intermittent front windscreen washer/wiper, front headlamps, turn indicators and hazard warning lamps.






