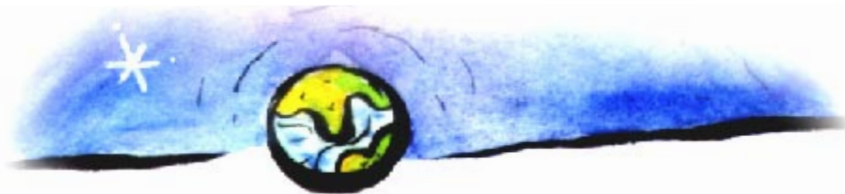

# THREE STEPS TO CERTIFICATION

The initial instructor certification is a three-step process. Adobe grants certification when you successfully complete all three steps.

## PASS THE ADOBE PRODUCT PROFICIENCY EXAMINATION

The Adobe Product Proficiency examination tests candidates' knowledge of a specific Adobe software application on multiple platforms.





This hour-long, computer based examination is offered at Sylvan Prometric Authorized Testing Centers throughout the United States and Canada. Please refer to the General Information section of this guide for fees.

You will receive your test results immediately after you finish the test. Your results will include diagnostic feedback to help you identify areas of strength and areas that need improvement.





## EARN THE CERTIFIED TECHNICAL TRAINER DESIGNATION

The Certified Technical Trainer (CTT) program is an industry standard that many software companies require of their certified instructors. The CTT program is based on the internationally recognized competencies identified by the International Board of Standards for Training, Performance and Instruction (ibstpi).





CTT candidates must pass both a computer-delivered test and a videotaped performance assessment to earn the CTT designation. If you have already earned the Certified Technical Trainer designation, simply submit proof of your CTT certification with your application to Adobe.

Candidates achieve the CTT designation when they demonstrate proficiency in the 14 ibstpi competencies:

- Analyze course materials and learner information
- Assure preparation of the instructional site
- Establish and maintain instructor credibility





- Manage the learning environment
- Demonstrate effective communication skills
- Demonstrate effective presentation skills
- Demonstrate effective questioning skills and techniques
- Respond appropriately to learners' needs for clarification and feedback
- Respond appropriately to learners' needs for clarification and feedback





- Provide positive reinforcement and motivational incentives
- Use instructional methods appropriately
- Use media effectively
- Evaluate learner performance
- Evaluate delivery of instruction
- Report evaluation information

# RECERTIFICATION

To insure that instructors know the most current version of each product, Adobe requires that all certified instructors become recertified within six months of a major product upgrade. Adobe will remind you of the need to be recertified. We will send confirmation of your continued certification two to four weeks after Adobe



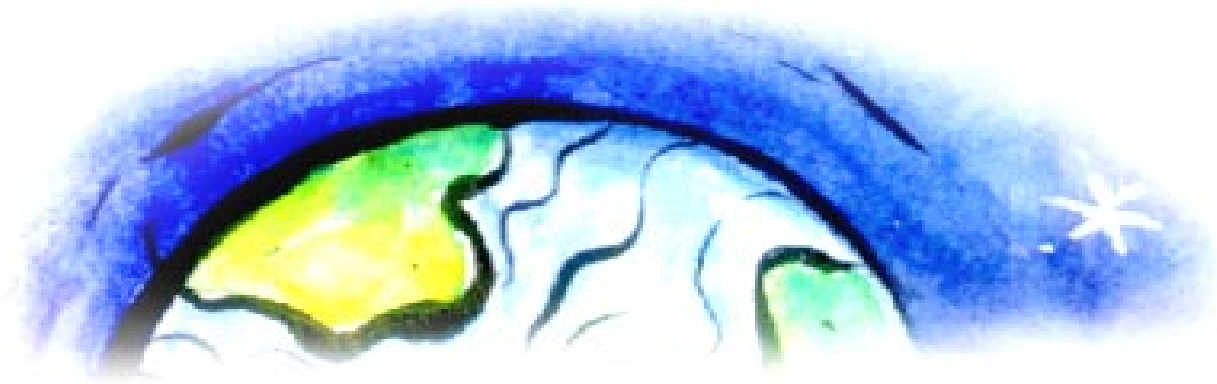




receives notice of your successful completion of the recertification exam from Sylvan Prometric.

You do not have to re-take the Certified Technical Trainer certification, required for initial certification, to be recertified by Adobe.

## EXAM REGISTRATION AND FEES

To register for an Adobe Product Proficiency examination at a Sylvan Prometric Authorized Testing Center near you,





call 1-800-356-EXAM (3926) from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Central Time, Monday through Friday. Testing is offered at over 600 sites conveniently located across the United States and Canada.

For your first Adobe product certification, the program fee is \$295, payable to Sylvan Prometric. Certified Instructors pursuing additional product certifications qualify for the discounted program fee of \$195.

## RETESTING

Candidates who wish to retake the exam must wait at least 30 days before doing so. Adobe encourages individuals to make use of the diagnostic feedback supplied with the exam score report to review the areas which need further study. One may take a particular Product Proficiency examination up to three times in a 12 month period. The retesting fee is \$95.





## RECERTIFICATION

Once granted, Adobe Photoshop Instructor Certification is valid for six months following a major product version upgrade. Recertification testing will cost \$95. You do not have to re-take the Certified Technical Trainer certification, required for initial certification, to be recertified by Adobe. We will send confirmation of your continued certification two to four weeks after Adobe receives confirmation of your successful completion of the recertification exam from Sylvan Prometric.
